PAT Testing

Throughout September, Department schools are required to undertake testing in Reading Comprehension and Mathematics using ACER's Progressive Achievement approach. The approach focuses on assessing and monitoring student growth over time and is underpinned by an understanding that students of the same age and in the same year of school can be at very different points in their learning and development. The tests are essentially for teacher use. Students from Years R-7 will participate in the tests. Tests are conducted on-line
